CUP RETURN:

Perpetual cups from 2024 can be returned to Finola Ferry ADCRG at the World Championships; or by other arrangement before 4th May (teachers-please contact me directly to arrange). Please ensure cups are cleaned, wrapped and ready to present.



FEIS RULES

- 1. Age as determined on January 1st 2025.
- 2. Solo costumes may not be worn in any competition up to and including Under 9.
- 3. Class costumes or skirt and blouse/top must be worn in all beginner competitions.
- 4. Facial make-up may not be worn in any competition up to and including Under 12.
- 5. All dancers are prohibited from wearing any form of glitter on their face.
- 6. No changing of costumes will be permitted in the hall. Dancers should be properly attired at all times. Changing facilities will be provided in the Feis venue.
- 7. The use of photography during competitions is expressly forbidden. This includes photography by mobile phone, video camera or Cine camera. Photographs may be taken during the presentation of prizes. Competitions may be added or withdrawn, depending on time.
- 8. The adjudicators' decision in all circumstances will be final.
- 9. <u>Litter must be placed in bins provided.</u>

PLEASE NOTE:

- Dancers can dance BOTH Light Jig AND Heavy Jig IN ALL GRADES IN ALL AGE GROUPS.
- To be eligible to compete in a Championship, competitors must have competed in at least one Open solo competition (excluding treble reel) and both solos in the Championship.
- DANCERS MAY ONLY COMPETE IN ONE GRADE PER DANCE (with the exception of dancers wishing to compete in the open championship who may double up for the relevant championship dances).
- Age Groups may be combined or split, depending on numbers.
- Cup Competitions: Dancers may compete in multiple light dance cups BUT must have danced chosen light dance as a solo dance in the same grade to be able to perform this as their cup dance.
- Confined Reel (Under 10 and above)- Confined to those dancers who have not yet won a 3-adjudicator championship.
- **Confined Reel Under 9-** Confined to dancers who have not yet won a Championship Cup (one adjudicator championship comprising of a light and heavy round).
