## **General Feis Rules**

- This Feis is run under the Rules of An Chomhdháil;
- Age as on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2026
- The decision of the Committee is final in all matters relating to the running of the Feis;
- The Adjudicator's decision is final;
- **No** changing of costumes will be permitted in the hall. Dancers must be properly dressed at all times;
- Facial make-up may **not** be worn in any competition up to and including Under 12. All dancers are prohibited from wearing glitter on their face;
- Competitors up to and including Under 9 and competitors in beginner competitions must wear class costumes or/skirt/blouse etc.
- The An Chomhdháil Social Media and GDPR policy will apply during the competitions and presentations;
- All dancers must appear in full costume for prize giving;
- A, B & Pre-Open Cups – Competitors must have competed in at least one solo in that grade to be eligible to compete in the Cup Competition;
- Dancers may take part in two cup competitions in different grades if eligible. However, dancers can only take part in **ONE Pre-Open** Cup Competition which must be in their **own age group**.
- Championships from U10+ will be judged by 3 Adjudicators
- Confined Reels will be adjudicated by one adjudicator only
- To be **eligible to compete in the Open Championships** competitors must have competed in **at least one Open solo competition**, excluding the solos in the Championship;
- Over 14 Pre-Open section may be split numbers permitting;
- Over 18 age groups may be split into appropriate age groups, numbers permitting.
- Dancers are requested to be ready to compete **20 minutes ahead of their scheduled start time**. If ahead of time, competitions may commence earlier.
